Coutts and Co

Hermes EOS

Over the last quarter we made voting recommendations at **88** meetings (**1,489** resolutions). At **50** meetings we recommended opposing one or more resolutions. We recommended voting with management by exception at **two** meetings We supported management on all resolutions at the remaining **36** meetings.

Global

We made voting recommendations at **88**meetings (**1,489**resolutions) over the last quarter.



- Total meetings in favour 40.9%
- Meetings against (or against AND abstain) 56.8%
- Meetings with management by exception 2.3%

Europe

We made voting recommendations at **40**meetings (**633**resolutions) over the last quarter.



- Total meetings in favour 47.5%
- Meetings against (or against AND abstain) 52.5%

North America

We made voting recommendations at **20** meetings (**302** resolutions) over the last quarter.



- Total meetings in favour 10%
- Meetings against (or against AND abstain) 85%
- Meetings with management by exception 5 %

United Kingdom

We made voting recommendations at **28** meetings (**554** resolutions) over the last quarter.



- Total meetings in favour 53.6%
- Meetings against (or against AND abstain) 42.9%
- Meetings with management by exception 3.6%

Global

We recommended voting against or abstaining on 151 resolutions over the last quarter.



- Board structure 20.5%
- Remuneration 41.1%
- Shareholder resolution 23.2%
- Capital structure and dividends 7.9%
- Audit and accounts 5.3%
- Poison pill/Anti-takeover device 0.7%
- Other 1.3%

Europe


We recommended voting against or abstaining on $7\,4$ resolutions over the last quarter.



- Board structure 16.2%
- Remuneration 47.3%
- Shareholder resolution 5.4%
- Capital structure and dividends 16.2%
- Audit and accounts 10.8%
- Poison pill/Anti-takeover device 1.4%
- Other 2.7%

North America

We recommended voting against or abstaining on $\bf 5\,8$ resolutions over the last quarter.
